

REPRIMAND, RESTRICTIONS

On November 22, 2012, the College of LPNs of N. S. (the College) issued a reprimand with Mr. Power's consent; and imposed a restriction on Mr. Power's ability to obtain a 2013 license to practice as an LPN.

The Complaints Committee set out the following reasons for the reprimand and restrictions.

It was alleged that Mr. Power was observed on video removing a DVD from a clients room, without her permission. Mr. Power was terminated from his employment.

Mr. Power admitted to the allegation and acknowledged his breach of Professional Standards of Practice.

Mr. Power's ability to obtain a 2013 license is restricted for a period of six months.

On January 9, 2013, Mr. Power consented to the reprimand and restriction of his ability to re-license for 2013.

The Committee further ordered that the Decision be placed on the website and in the College Newsletter.
