

REPRIMAND WITH CONSENT

On November 23rd 2015, the Complaints Committee of the College of Licensed Practical Nurses of Nova Scotia (CLPNNS/College) issued a Reprimand with the consent to Lisa MacCallum, for professional misconduct and/or conduct unbecoming the profession. On December 2nd 2015, Ms. MacCallum consented to the Reprimand.

The Complaints Committee issued a “Reprimand” with consent in accordance with the LPN Regulations (2009) under Section 35(3)(d) for the following reasons:

1. Ms. MacCallum failed to accept accountability for her actions in relation to providing inappropriate substances for resident use resulting in her termination.
2. Ms. MacCallum failed to adhere to agency policies in relation to use of agency property; bringing personal items to the unit as well as breaching the agency’s Discrimination Free Environment Policy and Bully Free Workplace Policy.
3. Ms. MacCallum failed to accept accountability in relation inappropriate medications practices.

Further, the Complaints Committee required that Ms. MacCallum complete remedial education related to the allegations as outlined in the Complaint.

The decision further provides that upon inquiry from any licensing body in any other jurisdiction, the College shall provide a copy of the full decision to the other jurisdiction in response to questions concerning Ms. MacCallum’s licensing status.
