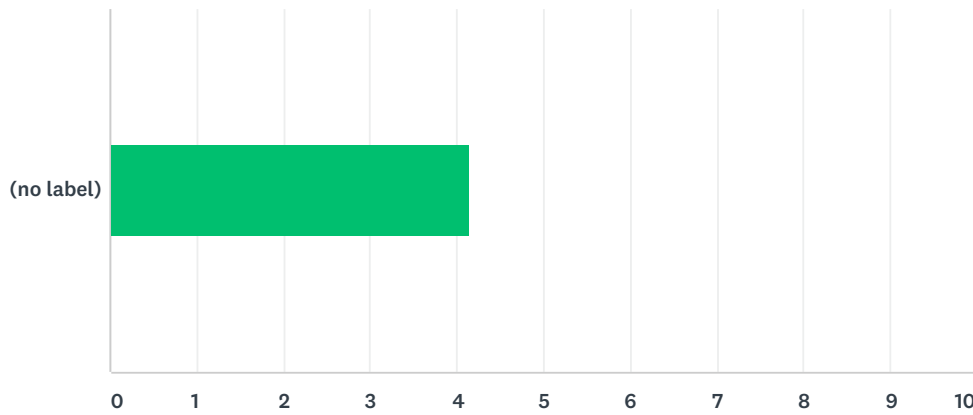


Q1 A self-assessment of my individual competence helps me identify my strengths and opportunities for learning.

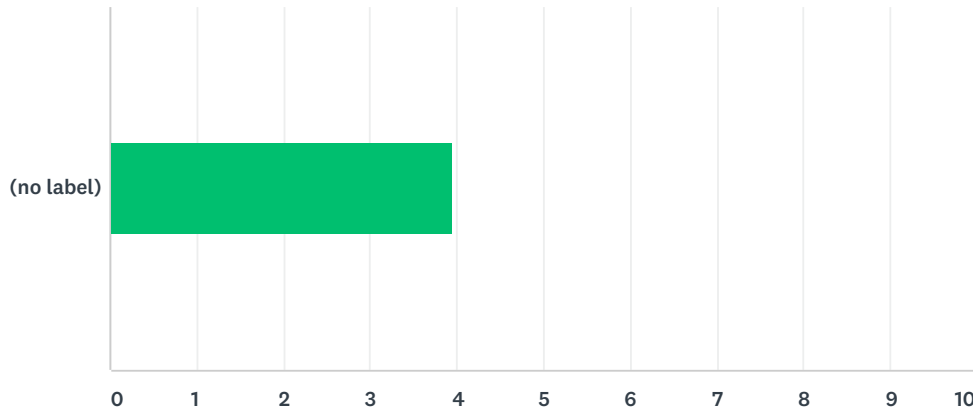

Q2 Creating an annual learning plan helps me focus on my professional goals.

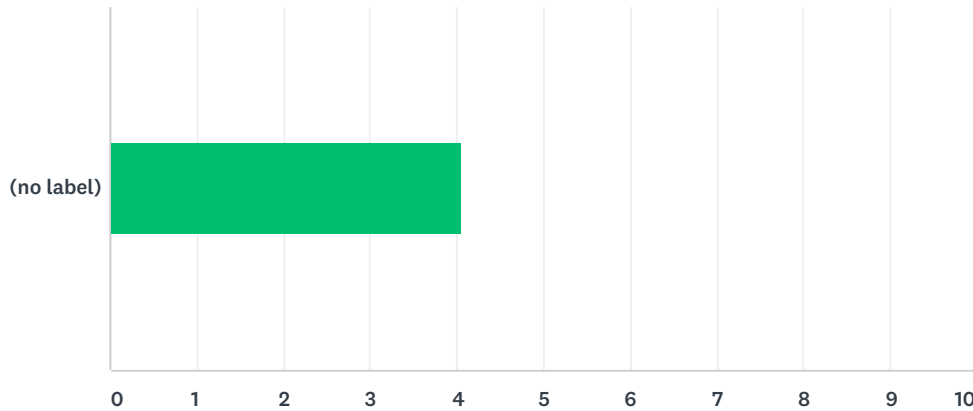

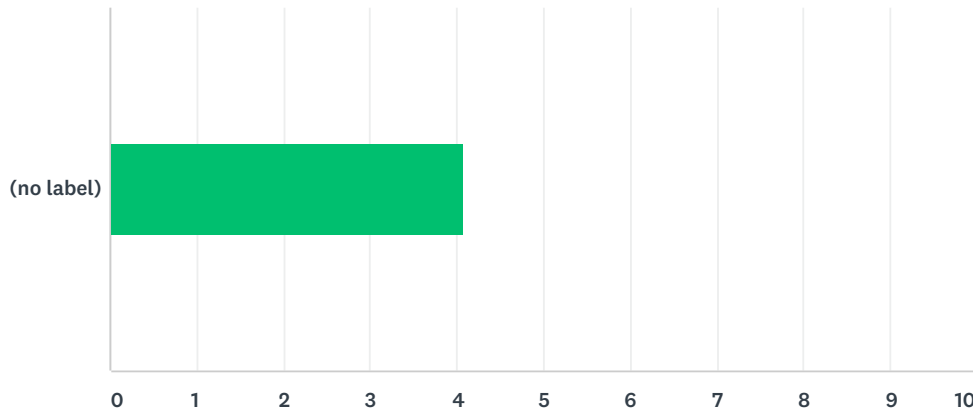

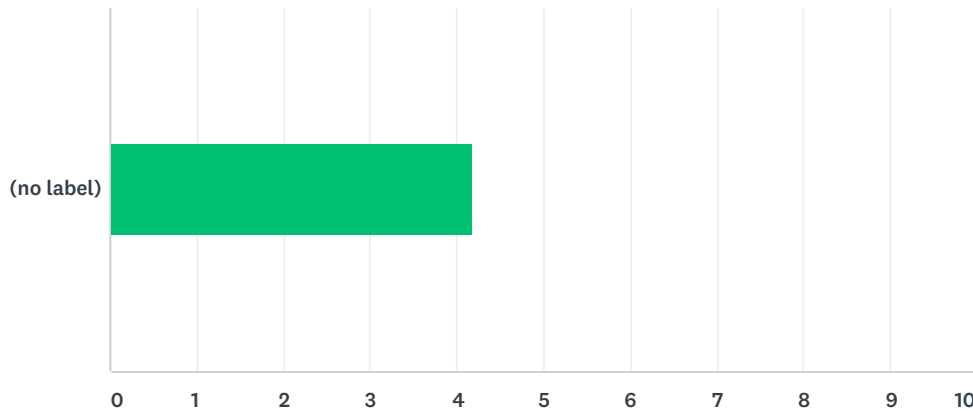

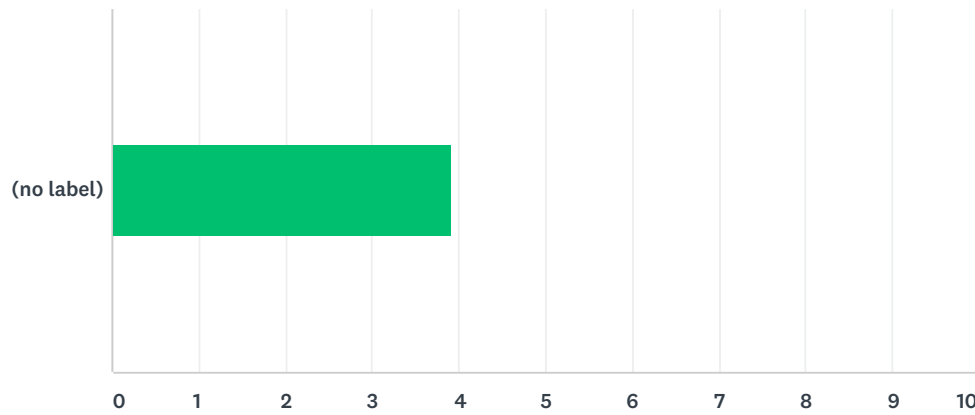

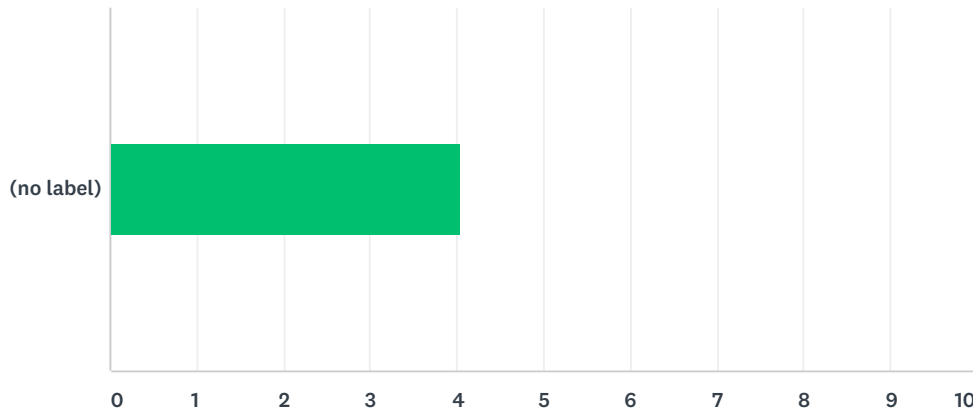

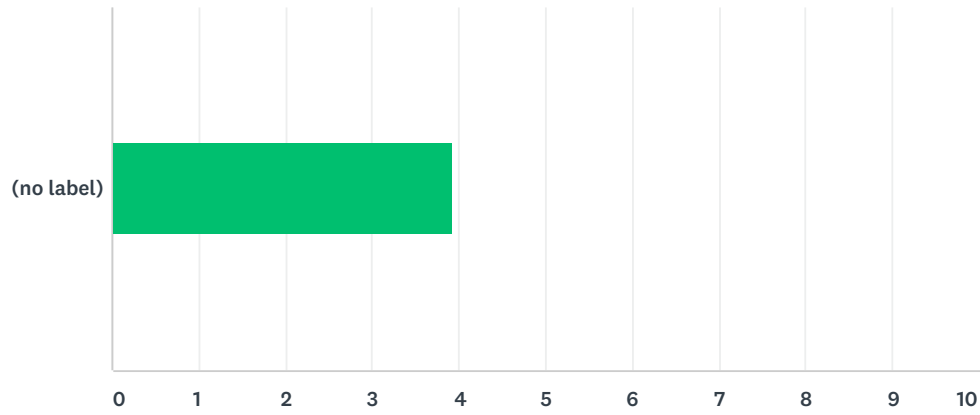

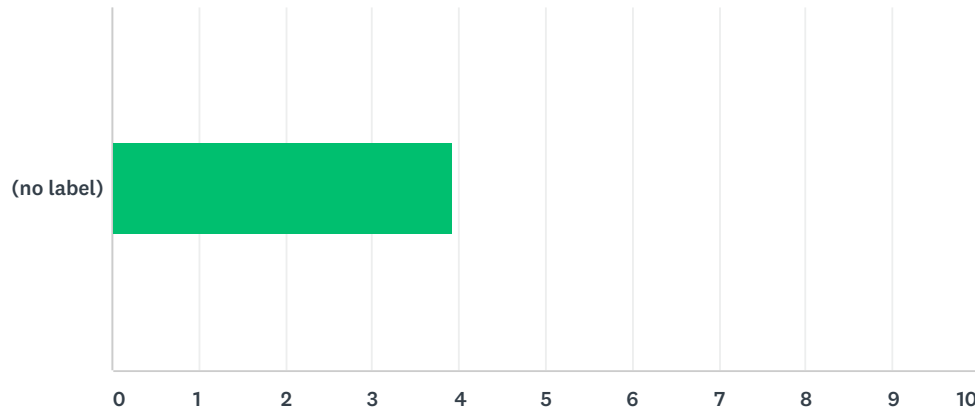

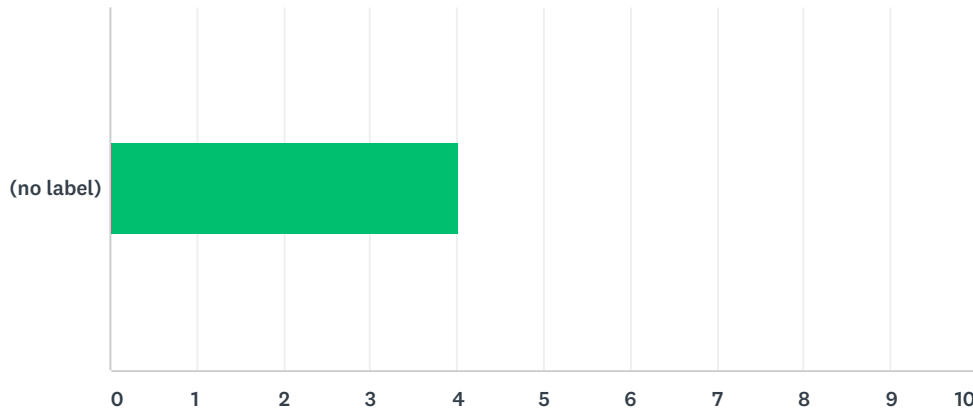

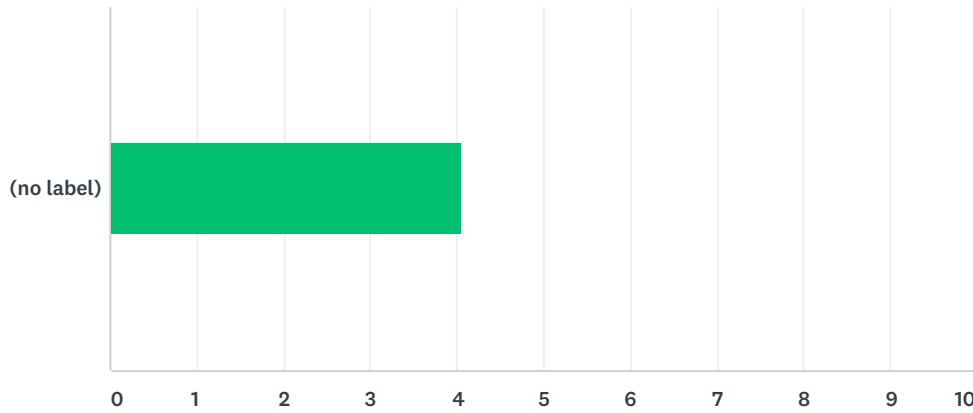

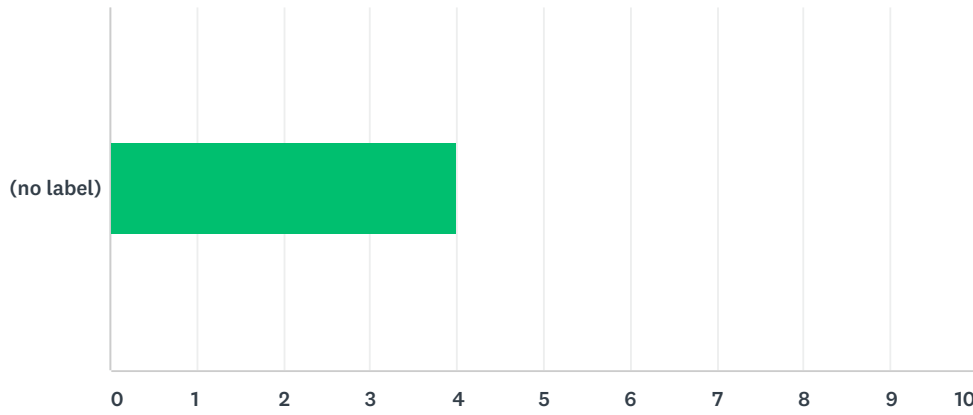

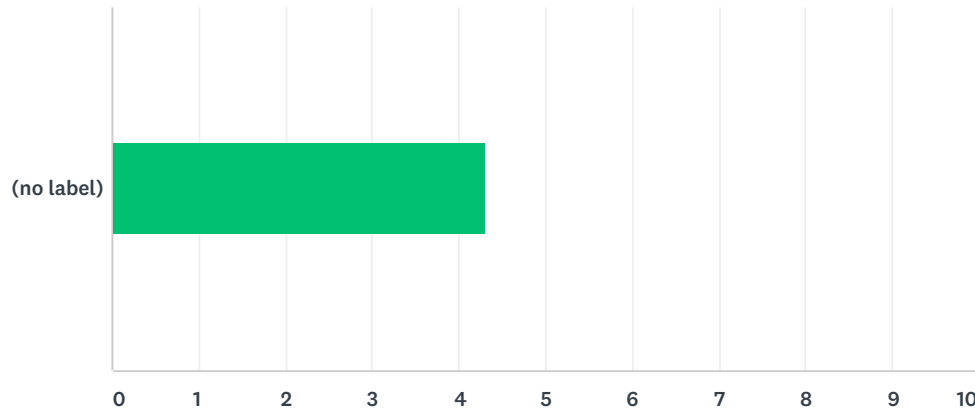

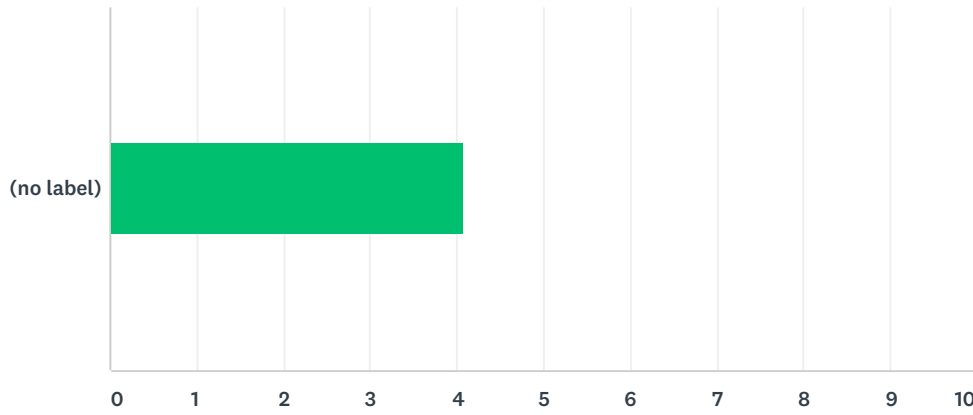
